PARK Roanoke Citation Payment Change Taking Place

Effective January 2, 2015, PARK Roanoke will accept payments for all parking citations (tickets), including On-Street, in its office along with several new payment options:



- 1) Pay in office by credit/debit cards. PARK Roanoke is located at 117 Church Avenue, SW
- 2) Pay by telephone with credit/debit cards by calling 1-888-272-9829 - use Jurisdiction Code 6246
- 3) Pay on-line by credit/debit cards or by electronic checks by visiting www.PARKRoanoke.com - Look for Oops I got a Citation, Pay a Citation

Visa, MasterCard, Discover and electronic checks are accepted. A nominal fee of \$1.95 applies for all parking citations paid by credit or debit cards and a fee of \$2.50 applies to electronic check payments. These fees are paid directly to the credit card service provider.

In a hurry and need to drop off a check payment? There's a secure drop box outside the main entrance door at 117 Church Avenue, SW.
