

## Residential Parking Permits

July 1, 2013

- Residential parking permits are intended to:
  - protect against unreasonable noise and disturbance,
  - provide reasonable access to residences, and
  - maintain peace, tranquility, convenience and character of residential neighborhoods.
  
- Process:
  - Parking study
  - Public notice of meeting published in *The Roanoke Times*
  - Flyers on doors
  - Community meeting(s)
  - Receipt of community input
  
- Permit program:
  - PARK Roanoke issues annual residential parking permits. One (1) application is required from each household.
  - Requires valid motor vehicle registration(s) and operator's license indicating residence in the designated permit area.
  - One (1) permit issued for each vehicle registration presented with a maximum of four (4) permits per household.
  - Two (2) complimentary visitor's passes per household.
  - One time "special event" parking requiring multiple parking spaces may be authorized.
  
- Fees – currently, \$5 per permit, subject to annual review.
  
- Transfer – may be transferred to a new vehicle or reassigned if a vehicle is sold within the household.
  
- Expiration – May 31st of the permit year for which the permit was issued.
  
- Parking signs will be posted in appropriate locations within the affected area.
  
- Enforcement of parking regulations related to the parking permit signs will be effective ten (10) days after the posting of such signs.
  
- Exemptions– Emergency, service vehicles, and construction/utility vehicles when on a call, delivery, or engaged in work on the streets or utilities.
  
- Participation in the program does not guarantee a parking space.
