PARKING DO'S AND DON'TS

When Parking, Please DO

- READ and OBEY parking signs
- Park as close to a curb as possible within 12 inches
- Display your disabled hangtag from the rear view mirror, as required by Law and the DMV
- Park in the same direction of traffic
- Lock your doors and remove valuables from sight

- Vehicles parking in No Parking or Restricted or Overtime parking zones may receive up to three (3) escalating citations per day.
- It is unlawful to remove chalk marks.
- Vehicles must vacate a timed parking space or zone by 500 feet and 2 hours before parking back in the same space or zone.

Remember DON'T PARK.....

- in No Parking Zones
- within 15 feet of either side of a fire hydrant
- within 5 feet of either side of a driveway
- within 20 feet of any intersection
- more than 12 inches from the curb
- in a loading zone designated for trucks
- in a loading zone for more than 20 minutes and you must be "actively" loading or unloading the vehicle
- in a space reserved for people with disabilities
- on a sidewalk, crosswalk, curb, median strip or any place that blocks an intersection or pedestrian access.

The City of Roanoke does not paint curbs.

Parking Signs—How to Read Them

The City Roanoke uses *many* parking signs to provide information about when, how long, and for what purposes a vehicle may park on-street or to designate specific curb uses. Sometimes two or more signs are combined when several regulations apply to the same curb space.

Signs are meant to be read from Top to Bottom. Also, they are color coded much like traffic lights. Red means there is a prohibition, limitation or No Parking while Green indicates parking is allowed.

Signs have arrows on a flat surface and only direct parking for the side of the street that the sign and sign pole are located. A double arrow governs parking on both sides of the sign. A parking sign regulates all parking spaces in the direction of the arrow until the next parking sign or the end of the block. Pay close attention to any exceptions. When reading signs, notice:

- Color
- Arrow Direction
- Times
- Days, and
- Exceptions

Is the Green arrow pointing towards your car? If yes, you may park there within the days, times, and exceptions or limits shown on the sign.

Is the Red arrow pointing towards your car? If yes, then do not park there.

If you are unsure, it's always a good idea to not park there. Only park where it is clear that parking is allowed.



This sign indicates vehicles may NOT park in spaces to the **LEFT** of this sign at any time.



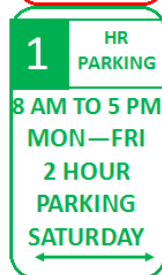
The sign to the right indicates that vehicles may NOT park in spaces to the **RIGHT** of this sign at any time.



This Green sign allows parking to the **RIGHT** of the sign for 2 hours only between 8 am and 5 pm and from Monday to Friday. Vehicles may park for an unlimited amount of time after 5 pm Monday through Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday.



This sign indicates that vehicles may NOT park on either side of this sign from 5 am to 8 am Monday to Saturday. Parking is unlimited on Sundays and from 5 pm to 5 am each day. Vehicles parked between 5 am and 8 am are subject to being cited and towed.



Subject the restrictions on the sign above, vehicles may park for 1 hour 8 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday. Vehicles may park for 2 hours on Saturdays between 8 am and 5 pm and for unlimited time on Sundays on **BOTH** sides of the sign.



This Green sign indicates that parking is allowed to the **LEFT and RIGHT** of the sign for the time limit, hours, and days of the week shown. Parking is unlimited at times and days not listed.

This sign indicates vehicles or trucks may park to the **RIGHT** of this sign for actively loading and unloading for 20 minutes only from 6 am to 6 pm. This sign is in effect Monday through Sunday. Parking is unlimited between 6 pm and 6 am.



These two signs indicate that vehicles are allowed to park to the **RIGHT** of the sign for only 1 hour Monday through Saturday between 8 am and 5 pm, but for unlimited time after 5 pm and all day on Sunday.



EXCEPT, there is no parking on either side of the sign on Wednesday from 11 pm to Thursday at 5 am. This is due to street cleaning.



This Green sign allows 2 hour parking between 8am and 5 pm, from Monday to Friday to the **LEFT** of the sign. Parking is unlimited for the days and times not listed on the sign.
